

## Requirements:

- Maintain a GPA of 2.7 or higher
- Stamford resident only
- Aspiring to attend a 2 or 4 year college/university or a specialized Trade School
- A letter of recommendation from a teacher/professor
- A letter of recommendation from a community leader
- Must meet the deadline with all the aforementioned documents in order to be considered for the scholarship
- Must participate in the round-table interview process
- Must present a bio and picture to the education committee
- Must present a typed, 500 word essay (based on choice topic of the Education Committee)

The following person(s) **do not** qualify for the Stamford Branch NAACP Scholarship:

- Executive Board members of the Stamford Branch NAACP
- NAACP adult members of the Stamford Branch
- Graduates seeking a Master's and/or Doctoral Degree
